

RESOLUTION OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL

A resolution 1) authorizing the submission of a full application in the amount of \$2,085,000 to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund to improve Hammond's South Wastewater Treatment Plant; and 2) naming the Mayor as the person who may sign for the City on the resulting loan (with a 0.95% annual percentage rate and 20-year term).

WHEREAS, the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF), administered by the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, provides financial assistance in the form of low-interest loans to finance sewer system improvement and other eligible projects—bringing communities into compliance with the requirements of the Clean Water Act;

WHEREAS, the City of Hammond has made improvements to Hammond's South Wastewater Treatment plant estimated at \$2,085,000, inclusive of design, construction, inspection, testing, legal, and other costs, a priority in FY18;

WHEREAS, the City's pre-application for a CWSRF loan in the amount of \$2,085,000 has been approved pending the City's ability to satisfy all regulatory and financial requirements, including a full application; and

WHEREAS, the City has been invited to submit a full application to finance the improvements above with a 0.95% annual percentage rate and 20-year term—minimizing the burden upon Hammond's tax payers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

- 1. Authorizes the submission of a full application in the amount of \$2,085,000 to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund to improve Hammond's South Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- 2. Names the Mayor as the person who may sign for the City on the resulting loan (with a 0.95% annual percentage rate and 20-year term).
