*A resolution 1) supporting the submission of a \$15,000 grant application to the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Fund for Historic Interiors for the preservation and restoration of the interior of the Miller Memorial Library, a designated historic structure; and 2) supporting a cash match of \$15,000.*

**WHEREAS**, the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Fund for Historic Interiors, managed by the National Trust for Historic Preservation, was established to assist in the preservation, restoration, and interpretation of historic interiors;

**WHEREAS**, funding of up to \$15,000 may be requested through the Fund for the rehabilitation, stabilization, and preservation of designated historic interiors—including through brick-and-mortar interior construction;

**WHEREAS**, the City is eligible and desires to apply for a \$15,000 grant through the Fund to preserve and restore the interior of the Miller Memorial Library, a designated historic structure, which, for more than 60 years, has served the Hammond community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is prepared to provide a \$15,000 cash match to the project should the City's application be successful.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY**

1. supports the submission of a \$15,000 grant application to the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Fund for Historic Interiors for the preservation and restoration of the interior of the Miller Memorial Library, a designated historic structure; and
2. supports a cash match of \$15,000.
