A resolution 1) supporting the submission of a \$250,000 grant application to the Land and Water Conservation Fund for improvements to Mooney Park; and 2) supporting a cash match of \$250,000 from the Grant Match Fund..

WHEREAS, the Land and Water Conservation Fund, administered by the Louisiana Office of State Parks Division of Outdoor Recreation, promotes broad-scope outdoor recreation, ranging from land acquisition to development of park facilities, such as splash parks, ball fields, picnic pavilions, and restrooms;

WHEREAS, the City is committed to creating opportunities for outdoor recreation for the entire Hammond community through the development of municipal park facilities;

WHEREAS, as one of Hammond’s oldest municipal parks—and one which has gone the longest without improvements—Mooney Park is an ideal venue in which to create new opportunities for outdoor recreation;

WHEREAS, the City is eligible and desires to apply for \$250,000 in Land and Water Conservation Funds for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared to provide a \$250,000 cash match from the Grant Match Fund to the project should an application be successful.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

1. supports the submission of a \$250,000 grant application to the Land and Water Conservation Fund for improvements to Mooney Park; and
2. supports a cash match of \$250,000 from the Grant Match Fund.
