



RESOLUTION OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL

A resolution 1) accepting a \$7,500 grant from the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Fund for Historic Interiors for the preservation and restoration of the interior of the Miller Memorial Library, a designated historic structure; 2) approving a cash match of \$7,500 from the Grant Match Fund; and 3) authorizing the Mayor or his designee to complete and sign related documents.

WHEREAS, following an application to the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Fund for Historic Interiors, managed by the National Trust for Historic Preservation, the City has been awarded a \$7,500 grant for the preservation and restoration of the interior of the Miller Memorial Library, a designated historic structure, which, for more than 60 years, has served the Hammond community;

WHEREAS, the City desires to use this grant for this purpose so the Library may continue to serve the Hammond community for decades to come; and

WHEREAS, the City is prepared to provide a \$7,500 cash match to the project so it may proceed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

1. accepts a \$7,500 grant from the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Fund for Historic Interiors for the preservation and restoration of the interior of the Miller Memorial Library, a designated historic structure;
2. approves a cash match of \$7,500 from the Grant Match Fund; and
3. authorizes the Mayor or his designee to complete and sign related documents.
