A resolution supporting the submission of a \$16,030 application to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Formula Grants Program to expand Camp Blue.

WHEREAS, the Capital District Law Enforcement Planning Council has notified the Hammond Police Department (HPD) of the availability of \$16,030 in Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Formula Grants Program funding for evidence-based projects/programs in following areas: gender specific services, mental health, school programs, delinquency prevention, diversion, and alternatives to detention/incarceration;

WHEREAS, the HPD is an eligible applicant for this funding; and

WHEREAS, the HPD desires to apply for this funding to expand Camp Blue, a program intended to prevent juvenile delinquency, including ungovernable behavior, gang participation, and crime, to engage and direct at-risk youth toward positive, productive activities, to build relationships among police, youth, and parents/guardians, and to promote mutual understanding, respect, and cooperation through a curriculum that covers basic police procedures, antibullying, awareness of surroundings, basic self defense, dealing with peer pressure, avoiding gangs, reporting a crime, and interactive demonstrations.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

supports the submission of a \$16,030 application to the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Formula Grants Program to expand Camp Blue.
