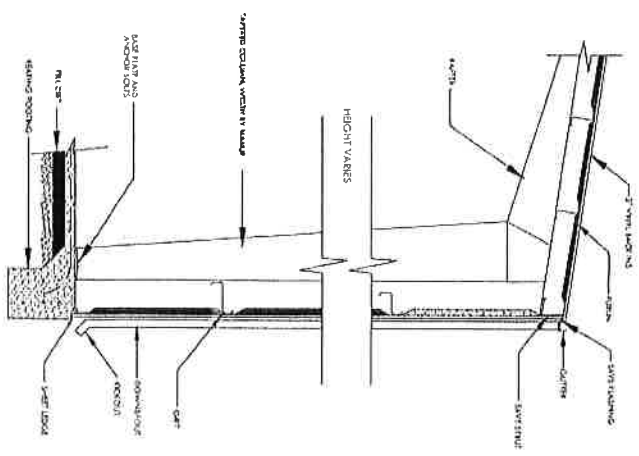

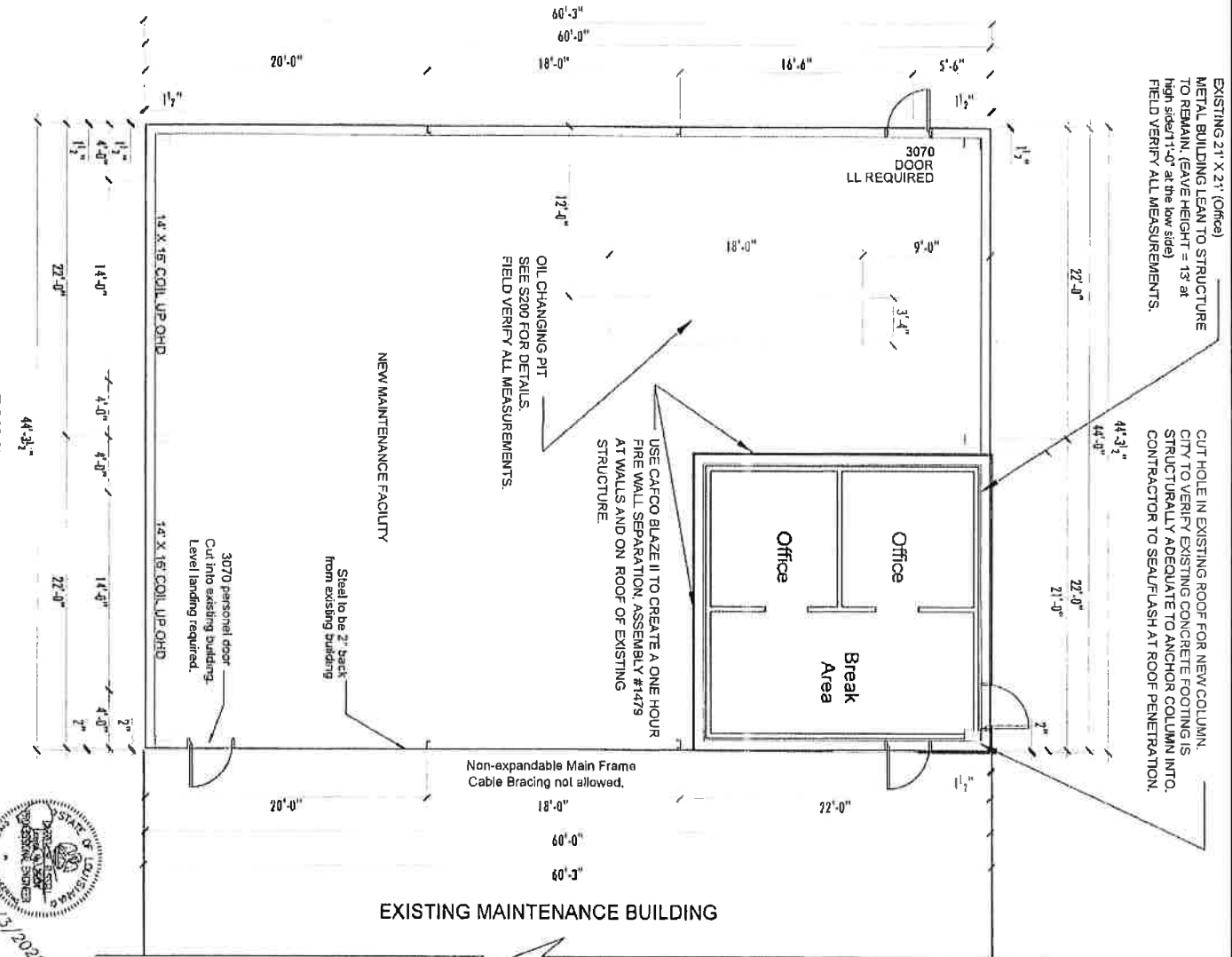

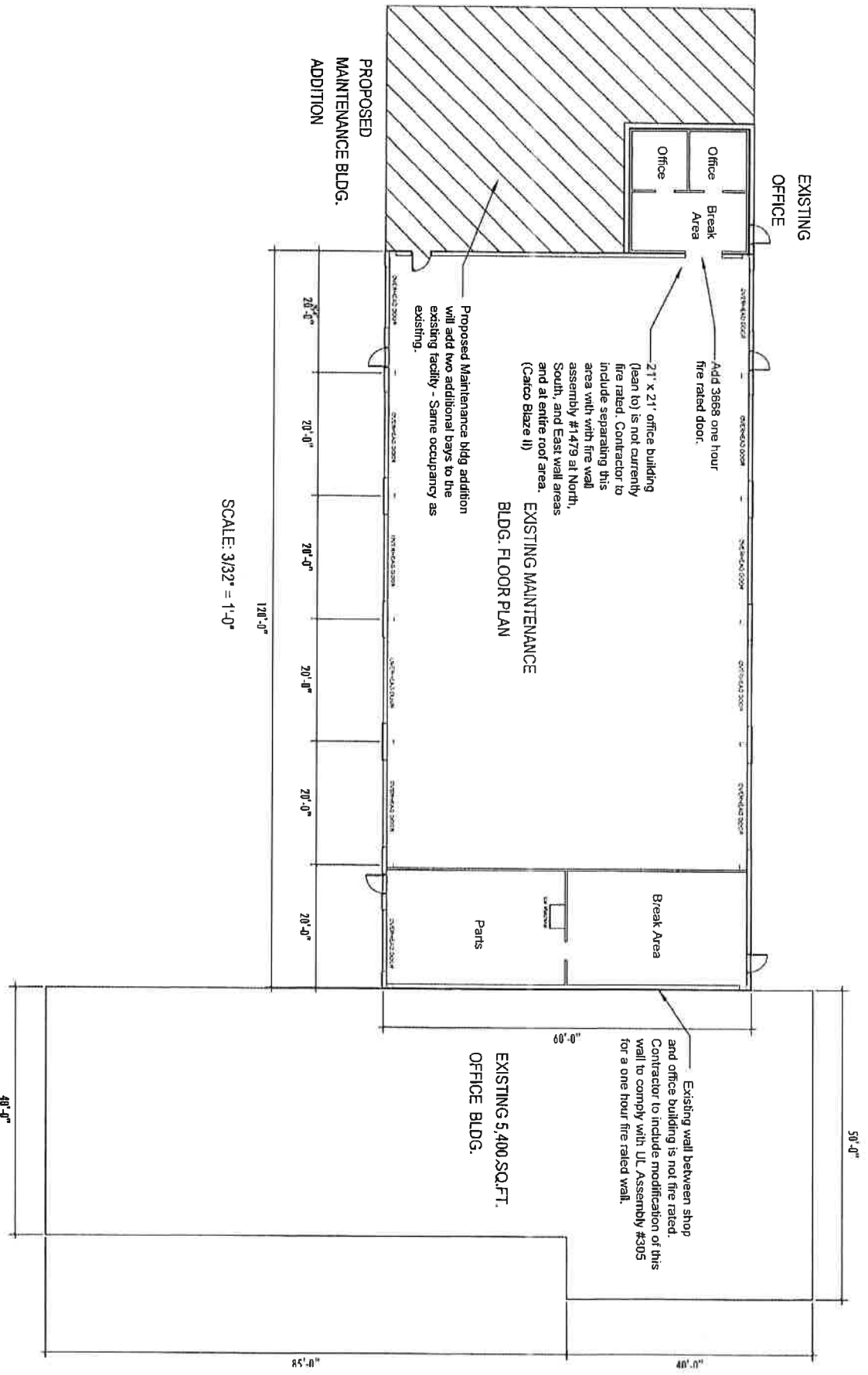
FLOOR PLAN
 Scale: 3/16" = 1'-0"



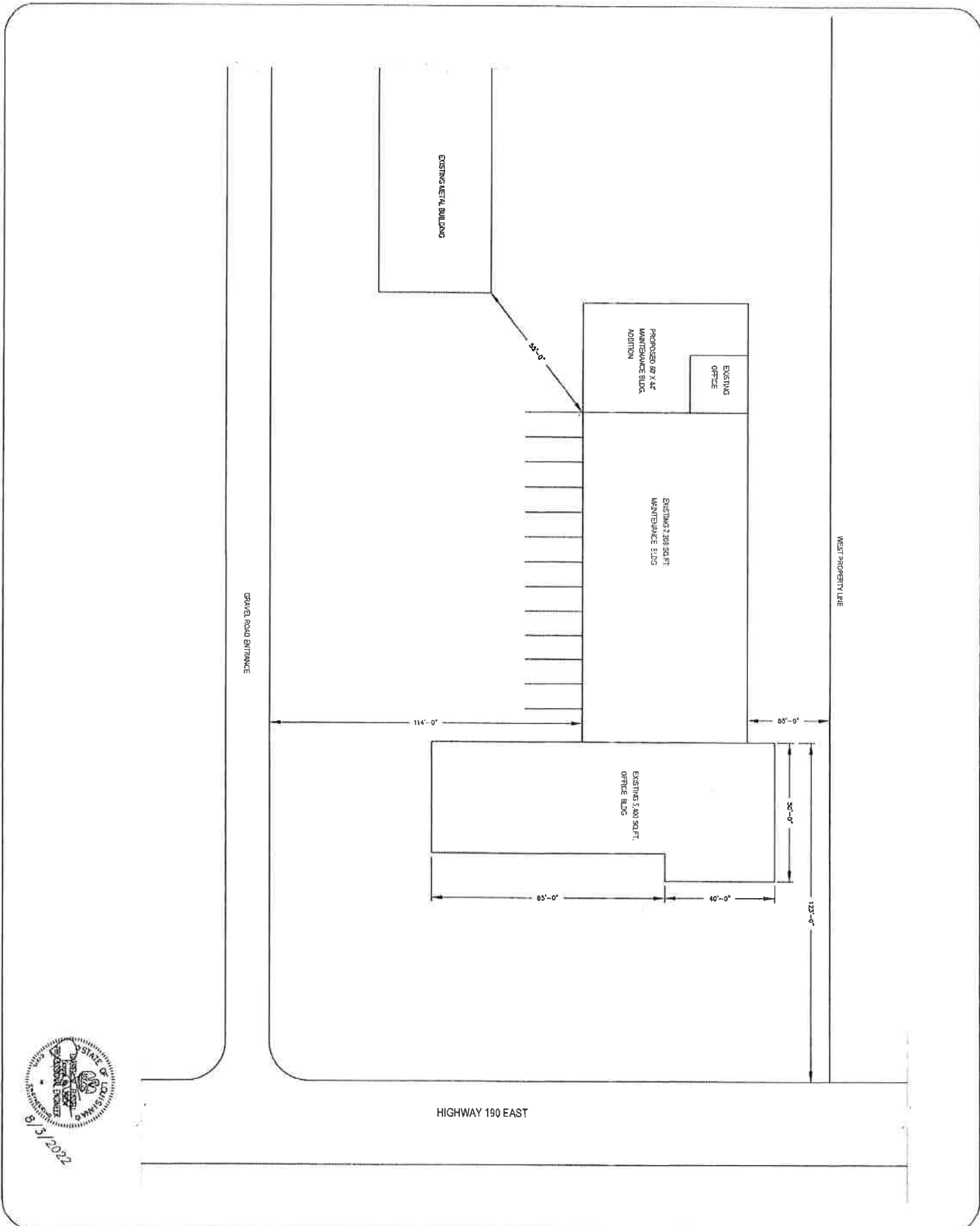
