



RESOLUTION OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL

A resolution 1) accepting a \$19,500 grant from the Community Water Enrichment Fund to install automatic water monitoring/treatment equipment at City water wells; and 2) authorizing the Mayor or his designee to complete and sign related documents.

WHEREAS, following an application to the Community Water Enrichment Fund, administered by the Louisiana Office of Community Development, the City has been awarded a \$19,500 grant to install automatic water monitoring/treatment equipment at 5 City water wells—Well 1 at 409 South Oak Street (which forms a corner with West Coleman Avenue), Well 2 at 709 Pecan Street (which forms a corner with Blackburn Road), Well 3 (the "Chevy Well") at 2101 Rue Denise (which forms a corner with Morrison Boulevard), Well 4 at 210 Tower Drive (which forms a corner of with US 190 East), and Well 7 at 301 1/2 Westin Oaks Drive (which forms a corner with Recile Lane; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of providing the safest and cleanest drinking water for Hammond's residents, workforce, and visitors, the City desires to use these funds for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

1. accepts a \$19,500 grant from the Community Water Enrichment Fund to install automatic water monitoring/treatment equipment at City water wells; and
2. authorizes the Mayor or his designee to complete and sign related documents.
