1. One supplier to support the purchased breathing apparatus and all apparatus' components.
 2. Supplier to provide on-site technician response within 24 hours from time of call for repair of products covered by the manufacturer's warranty.
 3. All SCBA's shall include - (2) 45-minute rated carbon fiber bottles, one complete SCBA harness (Total 60 Cylinders).
 4. 90 Masks with sizes to be determined the City of Hammond Fire Department and given to the awarded bidder prior to order being placed.
 5. Supplier to provide five one copy of an operations, parts, and service manual. SCBA - must comply with the most up to date NFPA 1981 Standard
 6. Integrated PASS device - must comply with the NFPA 1982 Standard, 2013 Edition.
 7. Mask regular must be quick connect and regulator assemble completely separate from the mask assembly.
 8. Masks must be voice amplification capable.
 9. Masks must not have electronics within the face piece assembly.
 10. 4500 psi, 45-minute carbon fiber cylinders (Must be less than 90 days old at time of delivery).
 11. Buddy breathing capability
 12. Pak Tracker Capable
 13. **Must include itemized pricing for any additional purchase of items such as masks, cylinders, voice amps, or SCBA's.**
 14. Include any Warranty Information that will apply to the products including, length of Warranty period and inclusions/exclusions. This will be a factor in awarding the Contract.

All proposals must be typed or written in **BLUE/BLACK INK**. Any erasures, strikeover and/or changes to prices shall be initialed by the proposer. Failure to initial shall be cause for rejection of the proposal as non-responsive. All proposals shall be signed. Failure to do so shall cause the proposal to be rejected as non-responsive.

Where one (1) or more vendor's exact products or typical workmanship is designated as the level of quality desired or equivalent, the Purchasing Agent/Fire Chief, after study and review, reserves the right to

determine the acceptability of any equivalent offered. The decision, after study and review, shall be final and binding. If proposing "equivalent" products, specifications, illustrative literature and any deviations shall be submitted with proposal. Representative samples shall be submitted upon request, if appropriate.

Liability:

The Contractor at all times during the term of the contract shall maintain and pay for property damage and public liability insurance with limits of at least (\$1,000,000.00) one million dollars inclusive of bodily injury and property damage for any one occurrence.

Prior to commencing work under this contract the Contractor must file with the City a "certificate of insurance" meeting aforementioned requirements with the City of Hammond named insured by added endorsement. All premiums and expense incurred with this insurance shall be paid for by the Contractor. The Contractor shall assume the defense of and indemnify and save harmless the City and its Officers and Agents from all claims relating to work.

The Contractor shall be responsible for any and all damages or claims for damages or injuries or accidents done or caused by him or his employees, or resulting from the execution of the work, or any operations, or caused by reason of existence or location or condition of facilities or of any materials, supplies, or machinery used thereon or therein, or neglect or omission on his part, or all of the several acts or things required to be done by them, under and by these conditions, and covenants, and agrees to hold the City harmless and indemnified for all such damages and claims for damages.

They have tried to submit an updated quote but honestly, we still would have to purchase chargers for the batteries and stuff. And we did not want rechargeable batteries in our scba's.

Scott comes with a lifetime warranty (15 years) and has the Pak Tracker and telemetry included in the quote. Also what MSA is calling buddy breather requires another separate purchase of equipment. It is included with scoot. No additional purchase necessary.

1. I notice the bank charger is listed as an option. Do the scba's come with chargers without purchasing the bank charger? The SCBA comes with either Alkaline battery back or a rechargeable battery pack at no additional charge when purchased. The 6- bank charger does not come with the SCBA. It is an extra item.
2. We asked for Pak Tracer, What is MSA's Option for this and is it included on the SCBA? The G1 SCBA has built-in Bluetooth capabilities in the unit. The telemetry accountability system was not included. (See attached)
3. The X3 Pro comes with quick connect fittings, Does the G1 you quoted, have that option as well? The X3 pro shows the option of quick connect. We quoted threaded. (See attached)
4. The RIT/Buddy Connection, Is it buddy breather capable or just standard universal RIT? Yes, ExtendAir II is buddy capable and also has the universal RIT connection on it.
