



RESOLUTION OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL

A resolution 1) accepting a \$50,000 grant from the Community Water Enrichment Fund for improvements to the City's water system; and 2) authorizing the Mayor or his designee to complete and sign related documents.

WHEREAS, following an application to the Community Water Enrichment Fund, administered by the Louisiana Office of Community Development, the City has been awarded a \$50,000 grant for improvements to the City's water system—specifically to purchase and install 5–8 insertion valves, which can be added to an existing water line—without a loss of water pressure and without requiring service to be shut off—to provide additional capability to regulate water flow at the point of installation—making maintenance, repairs, and even new water line installations easier, quicker, less disruptive to water users, and safer for everyone; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of continuing to provide safe and clean drinking water for Hammond's residents, workforce, and visitors, the City desires to use these funds for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

1. accepts a \$50,000 grant from the Community Water Enrichment Fund for improvements to the City's water system; and
2. authorizes the Mayor or his designee to complete and sign related documents.
