

ORDINANCE OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL

NO. _____

An ordinance of the Hammond City Council amending the City of Hammond Louisiana Unified Development Code and directing the City Planner, through the Mayor, to collect fees equal to the costs assumed by the City of Hammond to record documents through the Tangipahoa Parish Clerk of Court, and the advertisement and notice of public meetings required of Planning and Zoning Commission meetings.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Hammond City Council, that:

SECTION 1: The City Planner, through the Mayor, is directed to collect fees equal to the costs assumed by the City of Hammond to record documents through the Tangipahoa Parish Clerk of Court, and the advertisement and notice of public meetings required of Planning and Zoning Commission meetings.

SECTION 2: The Unified Development Code is hereby amended.

SECTION 3: This amendment shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Hammond Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall become effective upon the signature of the Mayor, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Mayor without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

Dear Lacy Landrum,

It has come to my attention that the fees collected from development cases are no longer able to fully cover costs to record related documents or provide for advertising and notification of each case. This ordinance will close these funding gaps, and provide the authorization necessary to be more responsive in our collections moving forward.

Recordation and notification expenses are distinguished by primarily benefiting the individual applicant, and being outside Hammond's control. Were either cost to increase, we would prefer to quickly make a proportional adjustment to our regular collection when the higher costs are discovered. This will prevent a period of deficit, and cover all costs intended to be covered at the earliest time.

All other fees have been excluded from this ordinance with the intention to include their adjustments as part of the upcoming budget submission.

If you concur that this fee update and authorization merits public consideration, please place the attached ordinance and exhibits on the agenda for introduction on February 27, 2024.
