A resolution 1) supporting the submission of an application of up to \$10,000 to the Healthy Communities Grant Program to purchase trash can liners and cleanup supplies to reduce litter in Hammond and 2) supporting a 15% in-kind match in volunteer hours.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Healthy Communities Grant Program, administered by Keep Louisiana Beautiful, is to provide funding for local projects and programs that focus on litter removal, prevention, and education, best practices for waste management, waste reduction, recycling, reusing, refusing, litter enforcement; and related efforts—especially those that with diverse community support, volunteer involvement, collaboration with stakeholders, and benefit to the community;

WHEREAS, the City, through its Keep Hammond Beautiful Committee, is eligible to apply for and is seeking such funding to purchase trash can liners and cleanup supplies to reduce litter in Hammond; and

WHEREAS, the City may apply for up to \$10,000 for this purpose and is prepared to provide a 15% in-kind match in volunteer hours should an application be successful.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF HAMMOND HEREBY

1. supports the submission of an application of up to \$10,000 to the Healthy Communities Grant Program to purchase trash can liners and cleanup supplies to reduce litter in Hammond; and
2. supports a 15% in-kind match in volunteer hours.
