Mayor Panepinto, stated this is the city's holiday schedule and they would like to add Friday the 21st of June and that the City Courts will be recognizing and he explained that they have an issue with Entergy and they will be doing some work on that day. He recommend that it be celebrated on the 21st and next year it will be accepted with the rest of the holiday's

Councilman Andrews, asked why Juneteenth isn't observed on the date of the holiday.

Mayor Panepinto, stated it was up to the council and he was matching what city court was doing and it was a day they had talked to Entergy about.

Councilman Andrews, stated he would like to see it observed on the day of the holiday.

Lt. George Bergeron, Chairman of the Police and Fire Civil Service Board explained that according to the statute the board has to hire a secretary and based on the population of the city is what determines whether it is a full or part-time secretary and the dollar amount is set by Statute. She worked part-time and full time. She was never officially hired by the Civil Service Board.

Mayor Panepinto, stated they were shorthanded and needed help in the building department and Ms. Julie helped out, she worked part-time in the billing department and part-time civil service.

There was a motion by <u>**Councilwoman Gonzales**</u> and second by <u>**Councilman DiVittorio**</u> in accordance with LA R.S. 33:2476 (L) (c) the hiring of Julie Monteleone as the part-time secretary for the Hammond Fire and Police Civil Service Board with a salary not to exceed \$1250.00 month.
