A resolution supporting the submission of an \$18,000 application to the State Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program to purchase portable radios for the Hammond Police Department.

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (BJAG), as administered by the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice, is to provide criminal justice funding to units of State and local government to support all components of the criminal justice system;

WHEREAS, in the interests of better equipping its police officers to respond to calls for service and improving communication between these officers and other law enforcement agency personnel and first responders, the Hammond Police Department (HPD) is seeking such funding to purchase portable radios; and

WHEREAS, the HPD is eligible and desires to apply for \$18,000 in BJAG funds.
