



**RESOLUTION OF THE HAMMOND CITY COUNCIL
REGARDING POSTAL DELIVERY**

WHEREAS, city residents have received notices that the United States Postal Service intends to requires certain neighborhoods to relocate postal delivery to the road; and

WHEREAS, the stated reason for relocation is to protect the safety of postal carriers; and

WHEREAS, the City has existing ordinances and is willing to put in place additional ordinances and take additional measures to provide for the safety of postal carriers; and

WHEREAS, relocation to the road will create a hardship for residents in these neighborhoods and a safety hazard for the residents and the public.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMMOND, that:

1. The United States Post Office and the local Officer in Charge is requested to maintain mail delivery at the homes of City of Hammond residents and not require a relocation to the road.
2. The United States Post Office and the local Officer in Charge is requested to communicate with the City Administration and the City Council so that appropriate ordinances and other measures can be taken to provide for the safety of postal carriers.
