**An Ordinance to Amend the Code of Ordinances
Regarding Alcoholic Beverages in City Parks**

WHEREAS, the Hammond City Council desires to promote the general welfare, provide for public safety, security and good order of City and thereby restrict the consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages in city parks;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Hammond Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:

A. Section 22-6 is revised to read as follows:

Sec. 22-6. Prohibition against consumption of alcoholic beverages and/or possession of alcoholic beverages in city parks.

- (a) There is hereby prohibited in any city park and/or public property adjacent thereto any consumption of alcoholic beverages, as defined in [section 5-16](#).
- (b) Additionally, there is also prohibited in any city park and/or public property adjacent thereto the possession of an alcoholic beverage, as defined in [section 5-16](#).
- (c) Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be subject to punishment as provided in [section 1-8](#) of the Code.
