Council President Andrews announced that he received a letter questioning the council's compliance with the State Open Meetings law. He further stated that in consultation with the city attorney, he will not allow discussion or comment of a matter not on the published agenda. If a member of the public wishes to speak on an agenda item, that person should approach the podium to be recognized while that item is being discussed. The three minute time limit per person for public comment will be enforced.

He also announced during council reports, only members of the council will be allowed to speak. Council reports should be limited to announcements or a report involving activities in your district. Questions to the administration or to others of a matter not on the agenda should be handled outside of the council meeting.

He stated as a reminder, a violation of the Open Meetings law may result in a fine or the public official ordered to pay attorney fees and court costs incurred by the complaining party.

He stated members of the public with issues in their district should speak with their council member. Issues on city matters should be directed to the mayor's office.
